What: Pat Bradley joins Ovations for the Cure’s fight against ovarian cancer at the “Driving for a Cure” golf tournament on August 4th. Presented by SBLI, The Savings Bank Life Insurance Company of Massachusetts, the 18-hole event will provide amateur golfers the opportunity to measure their ability against the hall-of-famer at a challenge hole. The tournament will follow the Legends Tour’s BJ’s Charity Championship from August 1st - 3rd.
